Membership Levels

*Full Membership \$115

- Full Membership is defined as any individual who is presently engaged in or has been engaged in explosives engineering.
- A member in good standing has the privilege of holding elective office, voting for officers and directors, and voting on changes to the Constitution.
- Blaster's license or proof of explosives handling **required**.

*Associate Membership \$150

- Associate Membership is defined as an individual who is interested in explosive engineering, but who is not qualified to be a full member.
- An Associate Member has all the privileges of a Full Member except they cannot serve as an officer of the society or vote on changes to the Constitution.

*Corporate Membership \$595

- Corporate Membership is granted to organizations rather than to individuals. The Corporate Membership entitles the organization to a maximum of three (3) votes and a maximum of three (3) seats at the Annual Membership Meeting.
- Corporate members as individuals have all the privileges of Associate Members unless, as individuals they are qualified and have been approved as if they were applying as Full Members, in which case they shall have all the privileges of Full Members.

Student Membership \$25

- Student Membership shall be a student pursuing a field related to explosives engineering and regularly enrolled in a post-secondary school or accredited two- or four-year college or university.
- A Student Member shall enjoy all the privileges of membership except a student cannot hold elected office, vote on officers or directors, or vote on changes to the Constitution.
